This wine shows bright, tropical fruit and an abundance of oak.
- Fontana Candida Pinot Grigio, Le tre Venezie, 2006** 7.
A great balance between acid and fruit flavors of melon and grapefruit.
- Tall Horse Chardonnay, South Africa, 2006** 6.
Tasty South African Chardonnay of a unique flavor character that adds length and depth to your palette.
- Penfolds Rawson's Retreat Chardonnay, Australia, 2007** 8.

RED WINES CABERNET SAUVIGNON

- 70 **St. Francis Cabernet Sauvignon Sonoma County, 2004** 45.
A big cabernet to complement any grilled meat as well as hearty pasta dishes.
- 71 **Devil’s Lair Cabernet Sauvignon, Margaret River, 2004** 38.
Intense red and purple hues with a deep complex nose of cassis, mulberries and a rich flavor of red fruits and berries.
- 72 **Caymus Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, 2002** 120.
Many wine critics agree that Caymus makes the best California Cabernet. We Agree. This wine is big, rich, exhibiting bright cherry and cassis fruit with nuances of oak.

Another great Cabernet from Napa Valley. Beringer has been awarded wine of the year twice because of the quality of this wine. Gobs of bright cherry and oak with a firm backbone of tannins and sweet vanilla.

Cherry and wild blackberry, with nuances of plum and mint make this quite a complex wine.

A rich, regal color with a fruity bouquet of chocolate, cherries and vanilla with a soft, spicy woody finish and aftertaste.
- 77 **Grgich Hills Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, 2001** 115.
Deep rich color with flavors of cherry, plum, and cassis with a long finish.
- 78 **Kendall Jackson Grand Reserve, Cabernet Sauvignon, 2004** 45.
Another award winning wine from Kendall-Jackson! Berries, vanilla, and currants accent this great wine.
- 79 **William Hill Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, 2002** 60.
A full bodied, fruit driven wine. Notes of cedar, vanilla, and cassis complement dark berry fruit.
- 80 **Groth Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, 1998~2004** 160.
With full, rich aromas and flavors redolent of ripe stone fruit and dark berries.

Marquis Philips is collaboration between American Dan Philips and Australian winemakers to make the most delicious, power-packed wines on the planet.
- 83 **Columbia Crest Cabernet Sauvignon, Columbia Valley, 2004~2005** 36.
Slight spice, chocolate, and hints of coconut and black cherry aromas lead into a subtle and harmonious balance of oak and fruit on the palate.
- 84 **Red Diamond Cabernet Sauvignon, Washington State, 2006** 30.
Fruit forward, cherries and chocolate with a good finish.

MERLOT

- 90 **Rutherford Hill Merlot, Napa Valley, 2004** 42.
Supple texture with aromas of berry, herbs and smoky wood. Rich and flavorful with hints of black cherry and chocolate.
- 91 **Stags' Leap Winery Merlot, Napa Valley, 2004** 50.
Loads of ripe fruit and soft tannin make this wine enjoyable with many types of foods.
- 92 **Freemark Abbey Merlot, Napa, 2002~2004** 45.
Cherry, plum, and raspberry flavors complement hints of cedar, oak, and spice.
- 93 **Franciscan Vineyards, Merlot, Napa, 2004** 42.
Supple and ripe blackberry, black cherry and hints of toasted oak and vanilla fill the mouth with a full mid-palate and a long, round finish.
- 94 **Clos Du Bois Reserve Merlot, Alexander Valley, 2004** 42.
A dark ruby red color, this lush and deeply flavored Merlot bursts with aromas of violet, mocha, ripe plum and blackberry. It exhibits flavors of black cherry, mocha and toasty oak, and finishes with a velvety flourish that makes this Merlot a delight.
- 95 **Nickel & Nickel, "Harris Vineyard" Merlot, 2005** 64.
This wine is remarkably supple and elegant, with a juicy core of ripe black cherry, plum, currant flavors.
- 96 **Columbia Crest Grand Estates Merlot Columbia Valley 2005** 45.
Classic Merlot spice, ripe cherry fruit, and cocoa aromatics which persist on the palate. The balance of wood and black fruits creates a velvety, seductive finish.

This merlot is rich with fruit, surrounded by elegant creaminess, supple oak flavors and firm tannins.

ZINFANDEL

- 110 **Rancho Zabaco "Heritage Vines" Zinfandel, Sonoma Valley, 2006** 25.
From the "winemaker of the year", this Sonoma County Zinfandel is teeming with aromas and flavors of black pepper spice, red and black skinned berries and vanilla oak.

PINOT NOIR

- 120 **Robert Mondavi Carneros District Pinot Noir, Carneros, 2007** 52.
Absolutely luscious Pinot Noir from some of the best vineyards in Carneros. Bright cherry fruit with nuances of vanilla and oak with a light touch of earth and tobacco.
- 121 **Blackstone Pinot Noir, Monterey County, 2006** 64.
Smooth, not very tannic with a flavor of berries. Full round taste with a clean finish.
- 123 **Chateau St. Jean, Pinot Noir, Sonoma County, 2006** 65.
Select vineyards in these areas were handcrafted into a wine with lush cherry and plum flavors balanced by notes of toasty oak.
- 124 **Mac Murray Ranch, Russian River Valley, 2006** 90.
This Pinot Noir is a rich and supple wine balanced by earthy aromatic notes and flavors of ripe, dark cherry and raspberry.

SHIRAZ

- 130 **Penfolds "Thomas Hyland" Shiraz, Southeastern Australia, 2005** 28.
Mulberry and blueberry with spicy oak on the nose and rich dark fruit flavors.
- 131 **Penfolds Magill Estate Shiraz, South Australia, 2004** 86.
Deep red/purple color with a nose of plum, cinnamon and spicy oak. Primary flavors of dark cherry and plum with secondary earthy notes and a long finish.
- 132 **Leng's & Cooter "The Victor" Grenache-Shiraz, Australia, 2005** 27.
Wonderfully rich and complex with berry, currant and toast aromas, layers of rich fruit, cocoa, and smoky spice wrapped in soft tannins.
- 133 **Columbia Crest Grand Estates Shiraz Columbia Valley 2002~2003** 62.
White pepper, strawberry, and freshly plucked rose petals meld with exotic spice notes to create a complex, balanced wine with a full mouth feel and supple finish.

OTHER REDS

- 140 **Ferrari~Carano Siena, Sonoma Valley, 2002~2004** 45.
This unique blend of Sangiovese and Cabernet Sauvignon has rich fruit flavors with lush strawberry and plum aromas.
- 141 **Beringer Alluvium Meritage, Knights Valley, 2001** 51.
This beautiful, bright red exhibits cherry and cassis flavors with a silky, soft finish.
- 142 **Ferrari~Carano Tresor Reserve, Alexander Valley, 2001** 80.
A blend of the classic Bordeaux varietals Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec and Petit Verdot. The mixture creates a classic and powerful wine that is dark, ruby red, with black cherry, cassis and chocolate aromas.
- 143 **Opus One, Meritage, Napa, 2002~2003** 250.
Robert Mondavi and Baron Philippe Rothschild created one of the world's finest wines. Loads of fruit show through with currant and vanilla oak.
- 144 **Franciscan Magnificat, Meritage, Napa, 2004** 65.
A wonderful expression of Bordeaux style California meritage. Napa at its best.
- 145 **Antinori, Santa Christina, Sangiovese, 2006** 24.
Long, sweetly fruity flavors of black cherries and spices are wrapped in soft tannins and adequate acidity. These vines were cuttings from Antinori Vineyards in Italy.

- 146 **Amarone, Bolla, Della Valpolicella, 2003** 75.
Italy at its best. Full bodied, smooth, long, lingering finish.
- 75 **Francis Coppola “Diamond Collection Claret”, Cabernet Sauvignon, California, 2006** 35.
A deep garnet color and enticing aromas of dark chocolate, anise, and sweet spices. Rich, lively flavors of succulent blackberry, currant, and wild strawberry are wrapped in soft, smooth tannins.
- 147 **Amano, Primitivo, 2006** 43.
Fruit forward, round, soft and full bodied.
- 148 **Silver Oak, Meritage, Napa Valley, Cabernet Sauvignon, 2001** 135.
One of the finest wines you’ll ever drink. Hints of cherry, and cassis in a round of full smooth finish. Aged in 100% American Oak Barrels.
- 149 **Chimney Rock “Elevage” Stags Leap District, Napa 2003** 115.
This top of the line “Elevage” is spectacular. Full fruit with a lingering finish.
- 150 **Rothschild Merlot, Vin de Pays d’oc, France, Merlot, 2006** 26.
This merlot has aromas and flavors of fresh, ripe plums and berries that carry through to a soft, silky finish.
- 151 **Columbia Crest Reserve Syrah Columbia Valley 2004** 62.
This Reserve Syrah, crafted in a Cote Rotie style, boasts generous Syrah aromatics of white pepper, cocoa and blueberry, with hints of Viognier’s subtly sweet orange peel, pear and rose petal.
- 152 **Columbia Crest Walter Clore Private Reserve Red Table Wine Columbia Valley 2003** 95.
The aromatics feature ripe cherry, raspberry, blueberry with oak-influenced mocha.
